Directly Modifying with Descriptive Verbs

When the last syllable of the stem ends in a vowel: add └-

싸다 (to be cheap), 빠르다 (to be fast)

Example sentences

- 싼 것이 있어요? Do you have anything cheap?
- 저는 빠른 차를 좋아해요. I like fast cars.

Directly Modifying with Descriptive Verbs

Since 하다 stem ends in a vowel: add ㄴ

조용하다 (to be quiet), 착하다 (to be kind)

 CONJUGATION: 조용하다 > 조용하 > 조용한 (a quiet)

 착하다 > 착하 > 착한 (a kind)

Example sentences

- 조용한 방이 있어요? Do you have any quiet rooms?
- 착한 친구가 필요해요. I need a kind friend.

Directly Modifying with Descriptive Verbs

When the last syllable of the stem ends in a consonant: add $\stackrel{\circ}{\leftarrow}$

많다 (to be many), 작다 (to be small)

Example sentences

- 거리에 많은 주차 장소가 있어요. There's lots of parking space on the street.
- 나는 작은 애완견을 정말 좋아해요. I really like a small pet.
